- 3-5 years of related work experience – this could be in fund operations, portfolio management, controlling, corporate finance, accounting or credit risk
- enthusiasm for sustainable finance
- creativity and commitment in overcoming day-to-day challenges as well as aspiration to deliver diligent and precise work results
- ability to work closely with remote investment team
- ability to work autonomously, and be able to prioritise effectively
- fluent in English and permission to work in Ireland

- willingness to occasionally travel to Zurich, or to meet project partners

- solid understanding of debt financing and/or credit risk
